

The Philippine National Police Internal Affairs Service conducted yesterday the Annual General Inspection- Operational Readiness Security Investigation Test Evaluation (AGI-ORSITE) at Camp Batalla and Col. Romeo Abendan .

Internal Affairs Service Central Office Officer Sr. Supt. Ramon G. Ancheta disclosed that the inspection is an annual undertaking on all police regional offices of the PNP nationwide to determine their readiness and efficiency.

During the inspection at Highway Patrol Group 9 under the leadership of Regional Chief Sr. Supt. Romeo R. Uy, Ancheta reminded the HPG-9 operatives to continue performing their mission and task in securing the different national highways in the country.
